- 1. Different ways to say dog poop: doggy do, turd, BM, dejection, doo-doo, dung, scat, excrement, faecal or fecal matter, feces, ordure, stool, solid excretory product evacuated from the bowels
- 2. Some dogs line up with Earth's magnetic field (north/south direction) to poop.
- 3. Healthy dogs usually poop one to three times a day.
- 4. A single dog will poop about 276 pounds of waste a year.
- 5. In the U.S. over 10 million tons of dog poop are produced each year.
- 6. The pet waste industry is a multi-billion-dollar market with tons of money spend on bags, scoops, and waste removal services.
- 7. Dog poop contains bacteria, parasites, and nutrients that can pollute waterways or spread to wildlife. One 40-pound dog's daily poop can contain 7.8 billion fecal coliform bacteria.
- 8. The bacteria in poop from 100 dogs in just a few days can shut down watershed areas to swimming and shellfishing in a 20-square-mile area.
- 9. Left on the ground, dog poop may take up to 12 months to completely break down.

Bagging the poop in a biodegradable bag is the most environmentally-friendly option.
